65%

- Tests
 - Tests will cover one unit of material and will always be announced ahead of time.
 - Unit tests will be a combination of multiple choice and opened ended EOG style questions.
 - Each student is responsible for all test corrections if needed.

35%

- Classwork / Homework
 - Each student is responsible for completing all classwork and homework when given.
 - If a student is absent, it is his/her responsibility to get the missing work.
 - You will receive a weekly homework assignment. It will be given out on Friday's and due the following Friday (unless there is no school). All work must be shown in order to earn full credit.
