## Grading:

There are two main components to your grade:

1. Tests / Quizzes / Projects (if given) -----65%
2. Classwork / Homework-----35%

### 65%

- Tests
  - Tests will cover one unit of material and will always be announced ahead of time.
  - Unit tests will be a combination of multiple choice and opened ended EOG style questions.
  - Each student is responsible for all test corrections if needed.

### 35%

- Classwork / Homework
  - Each student is responsible for completing all classwork and homework when given.
  - If a student is absent, it is his/her responsibility to get the missing work.
  - You will receive a **weekly** homework assignment. It will be given out on Friday's and due the following Friday (unless there is no school). **All work must be shown in order to earn full credit.**

**Grading Scale:**

- 90 – 100 = A
- 80 – 89 = B
- 70 – 79 = C
- 60 – 69 = D
- 0 – 59 = F

**Cheating:** Students are expected to do their own work. **Copying** someone else's class work and/or homework is **CHEATING**. Anyone copying work for ANY of their classes will have their assignment **AND** the one being copied, taken up and BOTH will receive a non-droppable zero for that assignment. Administration and your Parent / Guardian will be contacted in this situation.
