Grading:

There are two main components to your grade:

- I. a) Tests / Quizzes / Projects (if given) ------65% b) Classwork / Homework-----35%
- 2. Final Exam: At the end of the semester / year, each student will take the North Carolina End of Class Exam (EOC). This assessment will count for a percentage of the student's Math I grade.

65%

- Tests
 - Tests will cover one unit of material and will always be announced ahead of time.
 - Unit tests will be a combination of multiple choice and gridded response EOG style questions.
 - Each student is responsible for all test corrections if needed.

35%

- Classwork / Homework
 - Each student is responsible for completing all classwork and homework when given.
 - If a student is absent, it is his/her responsibility to get the missing work.
 - Homework may or may not be given every day.
 - All homework assignments are due the day after it is assigned unless otherwise noted.
 All work must be shown in order to earn full credit.

Grade Reports:

- Parent(s) / Guardian(s) and students should access PowerSchool weekly to access grades.
- Interim reports will be sent home each quarter to ensure parent(s) / guardian(s) are aware of grades.
